

## 1923 - The Year of Crisis

Your task is to work in groups of three to create a RADIO BROADCAST about the crisis in 1923.

- ?? One of you will need to write a script about the MUNICH PUTSCH
- ?? All of you need to write the conclusion explaining how the events were linked

You can use the following guide to help you write your broadcast:

You have to imagine that you are a reporter who was actually at the event you are describing and are telling someone what happened.

Start off by explaining how the crisis started in the first place, then give some examples of what was happening including some of the people involved. Finish off by explaining how you think ordinary Germans feel about the crisis.

Once you have written your own section you need to work with your group to write the conclusion
