

Thinking through the Slave Trade



This is the TASC wheel, a framework to help students think more clearly, organise their work more effectively and become more independent workers.

Using TASC to create a monument to commemorate the end of the Slave Trade, 1807

Gather and Organise - Create a mind-map about the Transatlantic Slave Trade: Stage 1 gather from memory - keyword 'Slave Trade'

Generate & Identify - What are the different types of memorials that can be designed?, what words should be placed on our memorial about the end of the Slave Trade?

Decide - prioritise your choices of design and wording?

Implement - have all opinions been taken into consideration in deciding on your monument? Now you need to produce your design

Communicate and Evaluate - be prepared to share your designs with the rest of the group, listen to peer evaluation and think about how effectively you worked on your own and in a team

Learn from experience - reflect on your experiences, what went well, what can be improved for next time.
